JBC, Incorporated in Scottsbluff has been recognized as one of the fastest growing private companies in America, according to Inc. Magazine.

The company received Inc. Magazine's ranking of number 2,549. This is a repeat appearance in the Inc. 5000 rankings for JBC. In 2008 they were the 3,831st fastest growing private company.

JBC is a transportation provider and wholesale petroleum fuel distributor based in Scottsbluff. The company sells and delivers petroleum fuels including gasoline, diesel, ethanol and propane. The company's transportation services are conducted in Nebraska, Wyoming, Colorado, South Dakota, Arizona, Utah, Nevada and Kansas. In addition to the fuels which JBC markets they are carriers for crude oil and refining by-products.

JBC has been in business since 1975. Owners are Jack and Betty Copsey of Gering. Brian Copsey, a son of Jack and Betty, is in charge of day-to-day operations. The company employs eight people in the Scottsbluff office and a total of 26 drivers over the delivery area.

Management credits their growth to close attention to customer service, operating safely, and adopting advanced technology to facilitate communications with drivers. In recent years the small family company has focused on their core operations of fuel marketing and liquid products transportation. Their contract hauling customers include Travel Centers of America (T/A Truck stops) and the Kwik Stops and Git 'n Split convenience store chains. The company delivers crude oil to the Frontier Oil Company refinery in Cheyenne and transports refinery by-products for the Garco Refinery north of Douglas, Wyoming. The company has become a marketer of ethanol from terminals in Scottsbluff, Cheyenne and North Platte. JBC also picks up fuel grade ethanol from plants in Nebraska and Colorado for delivery along Colorado's front range.
